Myrmarachne eugenei (Simon, 1900)

[*] **Emertonius rufescens** sp. nov. — Long. 5 mill. — Cephalothorax longus, fere parallelus, humilis et supra planus, sed postice abrupte declivis, parte cephalica subtiliter coriacea, aurantiaca, in medio confuse obscuriore, utrinque maculis ocularibus nigris notata, thoracica grossius coriacea castanea. Oculi antici pilis albis longis cincti. Abdomen angustum et longum, antice leviter prominulum, obtusum et emarginatum, postice sensim attenuatum, omnino luteo-testaceum. Chelæ rufo-castaneæ, breves et læves. Sternum pedesque lutea, patellis tibiisque anticis rufulo-tinctis. Pedes 1ⁱ paris tibia subtus leviter deplanata, aculeis longis et pronis (apicalibus minoribus), 5-5 armata, metatarso leviter curvato, tibia fere duplo brevior, aculeis 2-2 subtus munito. Pedes 2ⁱ paris tibia subtus aculeo parvo submedio, metatarso aculeis apicalibus minutissimis armatis. Pedes-maxillares pallide lutei. — Madagascar : Diego-Suarez (Ch. Alluaud).
